

Codota – Privacy Policy

Codota Dot Com Ltd. ("Codota", "we" or "us") is committed to protecting the privacy of its users ("users" or "you"). This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") has been created to inform you about how we manage, collect, store and use the information you provide in connection with our services and/or (ii) website and/or (iii) desktop application which runs on your device and suggests Suggested Codes (as defined below) and/or (iv) additional components to code development environment provided by Codota (collectively, the "Services"). Please note that the scope of this Privacy Policy is limited only to information collected by us through your use of the Services.

By clicking on the "I Agree" or such similar button provided by Codota prior to accessing any of the Services, you agree to the collection and use of your personal information as outlined in this Privacy Policy. We may amend the Privacy Policy from time to time, and we encourage you to consult the Privacy Policy regularly for changes. You understand and agree that we will treat your continued use of our Services after such changes have been published as your acceptance of the updated Privacy Policy.

Information Collected

Our primary objective in collecting user information is to provide and enhance the Services and to enable users to enjoy the Services.

We do not rent, sell, share, or trade your personal information with third parties other than as disclosed within this Privacy Policy.

In order to register to our Services, you may be asked, if and as applicable, to sign-in using your relevant authentication provider service or social network's login (such as your Facebook login). By doing this, you authorize us, as applicable, to access certain social network account information, including information about your social network contacts (such as your Facebook friends). By allowing us to access your social network's account, you understand that we will obtain and may share, without limitation, your name and profile picture, as well as the name and profile picture of your contacts.

When you register to, or use, the Services or any portion thereof, we may collect and record the information you provide to us, whether through the Services or through social networks or other third party services (the "Account Information"). We may also collect and store personal information about other people that is available to us through your social network login.

Personal Information

"Personal information" means information about you that can be used to contact or identify you. The personal information types collected in accordance with the Services may vary depending on the activity and may, without limitation, include:

1. Your name;
2. Your social network or third party service user identification details;
3. Your e-mail address;
4. Location (city and country);
5. List of the members you are connected with through the applicable social network (such as a friend list);
6. Your profile pictures; and
7. Any other relevant information included in your application, social network or other online profile.

Non-Personal Information

"Non-personal information" is information that, when taken alone, cannot be used to identify or contact you. During your use of the Services we may collect non-personal information about your use of the Services. We may also invite you to share non-personal information about yourself which may, without limitation, include:

1. Your age or date of birth;
2. Your gender;
3. Your code-development environment and the activities performed therein; and
4. Any other information included in your application, social network or other online profile.

If non-personal information is collected for an activity that also requires personal information, we may combine your non-personal information with your personal information in an attempt to provide you with a better user experience, to improve the value and quality of the Services and to analyze how the Services are used.

In addition to information collected as described above, you may choose to share additional information about yourself through the Services. Any additional image or information you provide may be publicly displayed. Please note that whenever you voluntarily disclose personal information on publicly-viewable screens or pages, that information will be publicly available and can be collected and used by others. For example, if you post your e-mail address, you may receive unsolicited messages. We cannot control who reads your posting or what other users may do with the information you voluntarily post, so we encourage you to exercise discretion and caution with respect to your personal information.

Other information we may collect includes your occupation, language, zip code, area code, location, and the time zone where a Service is used, as well as information about your computer, software, platform, incident data, Internet Protocol (IP) address, network Media Access Control (MAC) address and connection, browser type, browser language, referring pages, exit pages and URLs, number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed and the order of those pages, the amount of time spent on particular pages, and the date and time of this activity so that we can better understand customer behavior and improve our products, services, and advertising. We may also receive either non-personal or public information from third parties in connection with market and demographic studies and/or data that we may use to supplement personal information provided directly by you.

Use of Your Information

The personal information you provide will allow us to send you messages regarding, among other things, new products, features, enhancements, special offers, upgrade opportunities, contests and events of interest. You may at any time opt-out of any of these communications.

We may also use personal and non-personal information, both individually and combined together, to better understand the behavior and preferences of our customers, to troubleshoot technical problems, to serve static and dynamic advertising, to enforce our Terms of Use, to ensure proper functioning of our products and services as well as to help improve Services and their content. In addition, we may combine non-personal information with personal information, such as an e-mail address, to administer loyalty programs, and to tailor our offerings and/or web pages.

If you choose to use a referral service to "tell a friend" about a Service, we may ask you for your friend's name and e-mail address. We will send your friend an email on your behalf inviting him or her to visit the relevant website or check out the Service. We store your friend's name and e-mail for the sole purpose of sending this e-mail and for redundancy checking, to be sure that your friend does not receive multiple copies of the same e-mail message. We do not keep or use this information for any other purpose, unless such friend registered to the Service.

In all cases of data access and collection, the personal information you provide will not be disclosed, rented, loaned, leased, sold, or otherwise voluntarily distributed to unaffiliated third parties and will be used solely for the purpose of providing you with and improving the Services and for any other purpose stated herein. We will retain your information for as long as your Codota account is active or as needed to provide you the Services. If you wish to cancel your Codota account or request that we no longer use your information contact us at the e-mail address provided in the "Contact Us" section below. Note that there may be instances where we are legally required to retain your information.

Access through Social Network Services

By accessing the Services through a social network, mobile device or other third party platform or service or by connecting to such a third party network, platform or service via the Service, you are authorizing us to collect, store, and use in accordance with this Privacy Policy any and all information that you agreed the social network, mobile device or other third party platform could provide to us through the social network / mobile device / third party platform Application Programming Interface (API) based on your settings on the third party social network, mobile device or platform. Your agreement takes place when you connect with the third party network, platform or service via the Services, and/or when you connect with a Service, or "accept" or "allow" (or similar terms) a Service to access your information through a social network, mobile device or other third party platform or service.

We may also collect or receive information about you from other users of the Services users choose to upload their e-mail contacts. This information will be stored by us and used primarily to help you and your friends connect.

Third Party Service Providers

We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate the Services or any portion thereof, to provide the Services or any portion thereof on its behalf, to perform tasks (e.g., without limitation, maintenance services, database management, web analytics and improvement of the Services) or to assist us in analyzing how the Services are used.

From time to time, we employ third party contractors to collect personal information on our behalf to provide e-mail delivery, product, prize or promotional fulfillment, contest administration or other services through the Services. When requesting these services, you may be asked to supply your name, mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address to its contractors. We may ask some third party contractors, such as, data analytics or market research firms, to supplement personal information that you provide to us for our own marketing and demographic studies, so that we can consistently improve our sites and related advertising to better meet our visitors' needs and preferences. To enrich our understanding of individual customers, we may tie this information to the information you provide us.

Browser Use

Note that in the ordinary course of Internet activity, certain information may be sent from your browser to third parties such as advertising networks and analytics companies. We have no control over the information sent from your browser to those networks or other third parties and recommend that you ensure that your browser settings prevent the disclosure of information you would not like to share.

Disclosure of Your Personal Information

You understand and agree that we may be required to disclose personal information if required to do so by law or in the belief that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to avoid liability, to comply with legal process, including, but not limited to a subpoena, statute, search warrant, or court order, or to protect our, or a third party's, property and rights, to protect the safety of the public or any person, or to prevent or stop activity we may consider to be, or to pose a risk of being, illegal, unethical or legally actionable.

We may also disclose information about you if we determine that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to enforce the terms and conditions of the Services or to protect our users. Additionally, we may sell, transfer or otherwise share some or all of our assets, including your Personal Information, in connection with a merger, acquisition, reorganization or sale of assets or in the event of bankruptcy.

Cookies

Like many websites, we may use "cookies" to collect information. A cookie is a small data file that is transferred to your computer's hard disk or your mobile device for record-keeping purposes. Cookies may be sent to a user's computer or a mobile device when such user accesses or views a Service. We may use cookies for one or more of the following general purposes:

1. To help us recognize your browser as a previous visitor and save and remember any preferences that may have been set while your browser was visiting our site. For example, if you register on our website, we may use cookies to remember your registration information. So you do not need to log into our site each time you visit. We also may record your password in a cookie, if you checked the box entitled "Save this password for automatic sign-in", or by such similar designation. Please note that member IDs, passwords, and any other account-related data included in such cookies are encrypted for security purposes.
2. To help us customize the content, experience, and advertisements provided to you on our Services. For example, when you access a web page, a cookie is automatically set by us, our service providers, or our partners to recognize your browser as you navigate on the Internet and to present you with information and advertising based on your apparent interests.
3. To help measure and research the effectiveness of features and offerings, advertisements, and email communications (by determining which emails you open and act upon).

The "Help" portion of the toolbar on most browsers should tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable most types of cookies. Please note that if you refuse to accept cookies, you may not be able to access many of services offered on our sites.

Our website also may use Web beacons (also known as clear gifs, pixel tags or Web bugs), which are tiny graphics with a unique identifier, similar in function to cookies, that are placed in the code of a Web page. We use Web beacons to monitor the traffic patterns of users from one page within our website to another, to deliver or communicate with cookies, to understand when you have come to our website from an online advertisement displayed on a third-party mobile application, and to improve site performance. We also may allow our service providers to use Web beacons to help us understand which emails have been opened by recipients and to track the visitor traffic and actions on our site. This helps us measure the effectiveness of our content and other offerings.

Links

The fact that the Services link to a website or application or presents a banner ad or other type of advertisement does not mean that we endorse or authorize that third party, nor is it a representation of any affiliation with that third party.
